PREFACE

The Indian Cancer Society (ICS) is a community-based volunteer organization dedicated to eliminating cancer as a major health problem. Its Vision is “**Conquest of Cancer by Choice; not Chance**”

The ICS was founded in Mumbai in 1951 by the renowned oncologist Dr. D.J. Jussawala. The Delhi branch was set up in 1983 by a group of enlightened citizens led by Mr. K. K. Mehta.

Cancer Sahyog (CS) is the unique emotional support group of the ICS, whose membership is confined to Cancer Survivors & immediate Caregivers. Cancer Sahyog was founded in 1991 by a cancer survivor. CS's members are living symbols of Hope - that there is life after cancer and there is treatment for cancer. These volunteers go to different hospitals in Delhi and NCR to provide emotional and financial support to the cancer patients. They provide literature, helpful suggestions and tips regarding side effects of treatment. CS volunteers were faced with many questions put by cancer patients and their families like-

- (a) Where can a poor patient stay paying a nominal amount?
- (b) Where should she / he go for different tests ?
- (c) Where and how should she /he find financial help ?

So on and so forth. Hence the CS felt the need to collect information and come up with a Resource Directory listing services and resources available to the cancer patients.

The first Resource Directory was compiled under the then President Ms. Renuka Prasad by the then secretary, Ms. Surabhi Kakker with the help of other members like Ms. Santosh Handa and Ms. Kanta Gopal. This Resource Directory was a list of a few cancer support groups and information required by the mastectomy patients. In 2007 , under the guidance, encouragement and inspiration of Ms. Jyotsna Govil and Ms. Renuka Prasad, I compiled the Resource Directory collecting information I could get at that point of time. The resource directory was updated in 2013. Today, once again, we feel the need to update and upload this Resource Directory.

We hope it will be helpful for the volunteers and the workers in the field of helping cancer patients.

HOW CANCER SAHYOG HELPS

Cancer Sahyog is the emotional support group of the Indian cancer Society, Delhi Branch.

Our blue coat volunteers first began visiting the Breast Cancer Clinic at AIIMS in 1991. Since then, they have interacted with thousands of patients in the 17 hospitals that they visit. The Volunteers who are either survivors or care givers, offer emotional support to the patients and their families. They bring hope and give the much needed support during this difficult time.

Cancer Sahyog also gives financial support to the poor needy patients, and over the years has disbursed about Rs. 7 crore to pay for their treatment.

In 2000, Cancer Sahyog started providing bras and prosthesis to breast cancer patients free of charge for the first time. They are available on payment in the Indian Cancer Society office as well as in Prashanti, the Complementary therapy branch of the Indian cancer Society.

Survivor's Day is celebrated annually on the 2nd Saturday of February with songs, dance, music and laughter. A true celebration of life.

A biannual magazine, NARGIS is published and distributed free to the patients in hospitals. It gives information, updates of the activities of the Indian Cancer Society and brings cheer to encourage the reader.
